RE: Intersecting Curve of Oberlin Avenue at Bowdoin Avenue - parking controls

Pursuant to Section 19.3 of the Town of Glen Echo Code, the Town Council hereby approves new, modified, or existing regulatory traffic control signs at the following locations:

NO PARKING OR STANDING


Oberlin Avenue, south side, entire block from MacArthur Boulevard to Bowdoin Avenue [this confirms existing signing posted by the National Park Service].

NO PARKING ANY TIME

Bowdoin Avenue, west side, entire block from Tulane Avenue to Oberlin Avenue.

**SUBJECT: A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH TRAFFIC AND PARKING CONTROL MEASURES (INTERSECTING CURVE OF OBERLIN AVENUE AT BOWDOIN AVENUE).**

WHEREAS, the Town of Glen Echo Code, Section 19.3.A provides that whenever it is necessary in the judgment of the Town Council to ensure the public and pedestrian safety, control vehicular traffic, limit or channel vehicle movement or speed, or control parking on streets and other public space, that body is empowered to provide for the preparation and placement of appropriate signs, markings, speed bumps, speed humps and other physical devices which limit access, channel vehicle movement, reduce vehicle speed, or otherwise divert, slow, regulate or control traffic or parking; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that the foregoing establishment of traffic and/or parking control measures would ensure the public and pedestrian safety control vehicular traffic, limit or channel vehicle movement or speed, or control parking on streets and other public space, and otherwise would promote the good government of the Town; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution was considered in open session on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of July 2023.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT:

RESOLVED that the traffic and/or parking control measures provided on the attached Order for Traffic Control Devices be and are hereby adopted, and the Mayor and Town Clerk be and are hereby authorized to erect signs and traffic control devices un order to effectuate the Order; and

RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption and shall be filed by the Clerk-Treasurer and kept available for public inspection.
